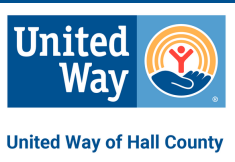


# 2022 Funded Program Descriptions



## **Brenau University**

### *Brenau Center for Counseling and Psychological Services*

Partners with other nonprofit agencies to provide no-cost mental health counseling to their clients in need who have limited income.

#### *Adult Basic Literacy*

### *Peer Co-Responder Program*

Provides one-on-one peer coaching support with a certified peer recovery coach and offers employment assistance, resume building, connections to local resources and treatment facilities, and regular social and service events.
