\$2 per week	Drink water instead of a pricey energy drink.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One week of Cub Scout summer camp for an at risk child.. • Clothing from Rape Response for five victims to wear home from the hospital. • Two patient visits to Good News medical or dental clinic including medications, x-rays, lab tests, and all medical/dental supplies.
\$5 per week	Make coffee at home and save time and money.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two weeks of occupational therapy for a disabled child at Challenged Child and Friends. • A hot meal from Red Cross for 20 people after a disaster, such as a tornado. • Aftercare for up to five victims or sexual assault from Rape Response.
\$10 per week	Brown bag it instead of going out for lunch.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A full year of reading instruction and curriculum for two students with Alliance for Literacy. • A safe and permanent drug free environment for an abused or neglected child through CASA's advocacy. • One year of weekly therapeutic counseling services for a high school student at Center Point.
\$20 per week	Have a night in and rent a movie instead of going to the theater.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lunch every day for one month for all clients at The Guest House. • Character building programming for an entire year for one child at Boys and Girls Clubs. • Ten days of safe shelter, necessities and support for a woman and her two children at Gateway Domestic Violence Center.
